- **A male Nursing Student, from the East London campus** has tested positive for Covid-19. He has been taken to the UFH isolation site in Alice. At the time of writing, his condition was considered to be mild. His contact has also been quarantined. We wish him a speedy recovery.
- **Three more Nursing Students are in quarantine** after being exposed to Covid-19 patients in hospital where they were placed for practical classes. They are being monitored daily and to date have not displayed any symptoms.

The Covid-19 Task Team is urging everyone not to drop their guard. The Eastern Cape Health Department has reported cases of rapid new infections in parts of our province. It is thus incumbent upon each and everyone of us to comply with all health and safety protocols. The return of the last cohort of staff and students to campus means a possible rise in transmissions and a possible local outbreak. We can prevent this. Our health is in our hands.
